






## What is your level of familiarity with AI?







# So is Generative AI a seismic shift or a fad?






## What is a metaphor for Al you would use? 176 responses

Information literacy

How to use it in research and learning! But not in writing academic paper





Digital and media literacy

Limitations of Al and it's not human, even though it appears to be.

LLM data sets created using people made to experience horrific working conditions and poor pay, that this black box tech makes more money for billionaires on the back of already exploited people.

Still getting to grips with what Al Literacy is, and what my role is in it.

Be critical, using the tools of critical literacy it can be applied to Al. Need to acknowledge Al but not centralise it Real life uses in jobs

It's important to raise awareness of how much energy it takes to power Al as it directly impacts the environmental conversations being had. Need to use it responsibly - (aware this is challenging).
